**INVITATION TO WORSHIP**

Leader: When the days drew near for him to be taken up, Jesus set his face to go to Jerusalem to die on the cross for us.

People: So we set our faces to the cross of Christ this day, and there we face our temptations.

Leader: We do not have a high priest who is unable to sympathize with our weaknesses, but one who in every respect has been tempted as we are, yet without sin.

People: Let us then with confidence draw near to the throne of grace, that we may receive mercy and find grace to help in time of need.

Leader: For we are in a time of need this day and seek the help of Christ.

People: We confess, O Lord, that there are times when we did not face up to our temptations, but gave into them. (take a moment for silent reflection)

Leader: Since then we have a great high priest who has passed through the heavens, Jesus, the Son of God, let us hold fast our confession.

People: For he has passed through death on the cross and gone to speak to the Father on our behalf to grant us forgiveness.

Leader: Your sins are forgiven because of Christ. And since he himself has suffered when tempted, he is able to help those who are being tempted.

People: We thank you, Jesus, for facing the cross, and not giving in to temptation, so that we might have the power to resist temptations by your strength. Be with us this day and walk with us on this final journey.
